Upper Respiratory Endoscopic Exam

No prep is necessary. Feed and water your horse as you normally would.

The night before your horse's Gastroscopic(Stomach) Exam

- No hay/grass or grain past 9pm
- No Water after 9pm
- if you currently administering any medication, supplements, or injections please withhold the morning doses unless otherwise instructed by the doctor

Anesthetic procedures

we use a combination of sedation to achieve optimum levels of sedation that are safe for your horse. An injectable anesthetic is given alone that produces a good plane of sedation with a quick recovery.

It is important for you to understand that there is always a risk of anesthetic and procedure complications anytime they are performed.
